These persons appeared this week in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Randy E. Black, 36, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to two (2) counts of Breaking and Entering, each a felony of the fifth degree and one (1) count of Vandalism, a felony of the fifth degree and one(1) count of Receiving Stolen Property, a misdemeanor of the first degree. He was sentenced to a total cumulative term of sixteen (16) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Alexander C. Kendall, 31, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for December 3, 2007 at 11:15 a.m.

Rob D. Lakatos, 38, Montpelier, Ohio pleaded guilty to Burglary, a felony of the fourth degree. He was then sentenced to six (6) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Robert D. Poppe, 24, Address Unknown, was sentenced on the charge of Robbery, a felony of the second degree to a term of four (4) years at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.
