These persons appeared this week in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Andrew J. Jackman, 19, Defiance, Ohio was sentenced to three (3) years of community control on two (2) charges of Receiving Stolen Property and three (3) charges of Breaking and Entering, all are felonies of the fifth degree.

Regina N. Kauffman, 21, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Trafficking in Crack Cocaine, a felony of the first degree. Sentencing is scheduled at the call of the court.

Amy J. Miller, 32, Edgerton, Ohio pleaded guilty to Aggravated Possession of Drugs and Possession of Cocaine, both are felonies of the fifth degree. She was granted Intervention in Lieu of Conviction.

Deanna L. Myles, 38, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced to six (6) months on the charge of Possession of Cocaine, a felony of the fifth degree to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Tracey R. Reliford, 36, Edgerton, Ohio pleaded guilty to two (2) counts of Non-Support of Dependents, both felonies of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for November 19, 2007 at 1:45 p.m.

Derek C. Riter, 20, Defiance, Ohio pleaded guilty to Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fifth degree and three (3) counts of Breaking and Entering, all felonies of the fifth degree. He was sentenced to three (3) years of community control.

Kenneth L. Switzer, 38, Edgerton, Ohio pleaded guilty to Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for November 19, 2007 at 1:45 p.m.
