These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

James L. Dodson, 37, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drug of Abuse, a felony of the third degree, to four (4) years and sixty (60) days to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction and a fine in the amount of \$1,300.00.

Nicholas B. Olson, 24, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on two charges of Trafficking in Marihuana, both felonies of the fifth degree to a total term of incarceration of eighteen (18) months, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Daniel J. Andres, 33, of Montpelier, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the fourth degree to twelve (12) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Dustin L. Bush, 20, of West Unity, Ohio was sentenced on two charges of Receiving Stolen Property and one charge of Vandalism, all felonies of the fifth degree, to a total term of incarceration of ten (10) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Tia M. Farrell, 27, of West Unity, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charges of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs and Trafficking in Drugs, both felonies of the fourth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for December 22, 2008 at 9:30 a.m.

Jerry L. Brown, 39, of Montpelier, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fifth degree and Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the fourth degree to three (3) years of community control.

Jeffery M. Sosenheimer, 28, of Ft. Wayne, Indiana was sentenced on two charges of Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug, both felonies of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.
