These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Adam H. Flinn, 30, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Illegal Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree, to four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Michael J. Metzger, 37, of Stryker, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Illegal Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree, to four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jeffrey D. Sutcliffe, 31, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on two (2) charges of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, both felonies of the fourth degree and Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the third degree, to a total term of incarceration of two (2) years and six (6) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Melvin C. Berry, Jr., 34, of Montpelier, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.

Crystal M. Conforti, 20, of Pioneer, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Corrupting Another with Drugs, a felony of the fourth degree, to fourteen (14) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Steven A. Clair, 24, of Montpelier, Ohio pleaded guilty to two (2) counts of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, both felonies of the fourth degree and two (2) counts of Trafficking in Drugs, both felonies of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for January 5, 2009 at 1:00 p.m.

Mark Z. Perez, 27, of Butler, Indiana pleaded no contest on the charge of Felonious Assault, a felony of the second degree. Sentencing is scheduled for January 14, 2009 at 1:45 p.m.

Shannon S. Reclus, 26, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on two (2) counts of Forgery, both felonies of the fifth degree and Aiding and Abetting Grand Theft, a felony of the fourth degree, to three (3) years of community control.
