### **March 5, 2009 NEWS RELEASE**

These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Jason D. Dennis, 23, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Illegal Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree, to four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Matthew A. Quota, 31, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, a felony of the third degree, to three (3) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Kenneth L. Killion, 46, of Defiance, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the third degree. He was then sentenced to two (2) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction. The 2005 Harley Davidson being operated by Killion at the time of the offense was ordered forfeited to the State of Ohio.

J. Tucker Harman, 19, of Edon, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, a felony of the fifth degree, to ten (10) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jessica R. Stotz, 21, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Aggravated Possession of Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree. She was granted Intervention in Lieu and placed on community control for a period of three (3) years.

Henry Case, 59, of New London, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs of Abuse, a felony of the fourth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for April 7, 2009 at 1:00 p.m.
