These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Bobby G. Stiltner, 72, of Montpelier, Ohio pleaded guilty to two (2) charges of Gross Sexual Imposition, both felonies of the third degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of six (6) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Brian R. Ferguson, 42, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Illegal Manufacturing of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree. He was then sentenced to four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Janell M. Ellerbusch, 39, of Spokane, Washington pleaded guilty to three (3) charges of Non-Support of Dependents, all felonies of the fourth degree. She was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of ten (10) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jason A. Gillespie, 30, of Ft. Wayne, Indiana was sentenced on the charges of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree and Forgery, a felony of the fifth degree, to a total term of incarceration of eight (8) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jeremy T. Feller, 29, of Pemberville, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for May 20, 2009 at 1:15 p.m.

Trenity Heller, 29, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charges of Grand Theft, a felony of the third degree and Misuse of Credit Cards, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for May 18, 2009 at 1:00 p.m.

Kyle W. Hickman, 20, of Montpelier, Ohio pleaded guilty to six (6) charges of Breaking and Entering, all felonies of the fifth degree and one (1) charge of Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, a felony of the second degree. Sentencing is scheduled for May 18, 2009 at 1:30 p.m.

Rodney D. Hill, 41, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to two charges of Aggravated Possession of Drugs, both felonies of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for May 18, 2009 at 1:15 p.m.

Timothy A. Sharp, 50, of Ft. Wayne, Indiana pleaded guilty to the charge of Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for May 26, 2009 at 1:30 p.m.

John L. Young Jr., 45, of Wabash, Indiana pleaded guilty to the charge of Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for at the call of the Court.
