These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Randy S. Langenderfer, 60, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to two (2) counts of Burglary, each a felony of the second degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of six (6) years to be serviced at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Michael L. Patrias, 28, of Hillsdale, Michigan pleaded guilty to the charge of Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the third degree. He was then sentenced to three (3) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

David G. Waue, 22, of Edon, Ohio pleaded no contest to the charge of Felonious Assault, a felony of the second degree. He was then sentenced to two (2) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Veronica M. Funkhouser, aka Stephanie Funkhouser, 30, of Montpelier, Ohio was sentenced on six (6) counts of Theft, all felonies of the fifth degree and a charge of Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.
