These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

David L. Blake Sr., 46, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs of Abuse, a felony of the fourth degree, to one hundred and twenty (120) days plus an additional term of twelve (12) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction and a fine in the amount of \$800.00.

Douglas P. Hall, 20, Montpelier, Ohio pleaded guilty to Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, a felony of the fourth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 24, 2008 at 1:00 p.m.

Jerime N. Miler, 32, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Domestic Violence, a felony of the third degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 15, 2008 at 9:15 a.m.

Aaron W. Pike, 26, Edgerton, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Receiving Stolen Property and Misuse of Credit Cards, both are felonies of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.

Erica L. Rahmer, 26, Edgerton, Ohio was sentenced on two counts of Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, Aggravated Possession of Drugs, and Trafficking in Drugs, all felonies of the fifth degree; and two counts of Trafficking in Prescription Drugs, both felonies of the fourth degree, to a total term of incarceration of fifteen (15) months to be served at the Ohio Department of

Rehabilitation and Correction.

Randy W. Ribali, 25, Archbold, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Attempted Arson and Breaking and Entering, both felonies of the fifth degree, to four (4) years of community control.

Angel L. Ybarra, aka Angel L. Martinez, 35, Angola, Indiana was sentenced on the charge of Forgery, a felony of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.
