These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Robert L. Fugate, 29, Rome City, Indiana pleaded guilty to Illegal Manufacture of Drugs, a felony of the second degree. He was sentenced to five (5) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

William J. Sharp, 40, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Theft and two (2) counts of Forgery, all felonies of the fifth degree, to a total term of incarceration of eleven (11) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Joel T. Gray, 32, Rome City, Indiana pleaded guilty to Illegal Manufacture of Drugs, a felony of the second degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 25, 2008 at 1:15 p.m.

Jessica E. Bail, 19, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.

William A. Bible, Jr., 36, Ashley, Indiana pleaded guilty to Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 24, 2008 at 1:15 p.m.

Shaunna A. Duma, 36, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Burglary, a felony of the third degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 24, 2008 at 1:30 p.m.

Daniel L. Mohr, 34, Defiance, Ohio pleaded guilty to Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree. He was then sentenced to twelve (12) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Beth L. Southam, 29, Montpelier, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Passing Bad Checks, a felony of the fourth degree, to three (3) years of community control.

James A. Summers, 24, Alvordton, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree, to three (3) years of community control.

T. J. Alan Tressler, 23, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Theft by Deception, a misdemeanor of the first degree. He was then sentenced to one (1) year of monitored time and a fine in the amount of \$500.00.
