These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Wayne F. Harris, Jr., 24, of West Unity, Ohio, was convicted following a two day jury trial of one (1) count of Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree, one (1) count of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree, one (1) count of Safecracking, a felony of the fourth degree, one (1) count of Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree, and one (1) count of Petty Theft, a misdemeanor of the first degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 14, 2009 at 1:30 p.m.

Richard L. Goebel Jr., 38, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to three (3) counts of Trafficking in Marihuana, all felonies of the fifth degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of eleven (11) months, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Lucas P. Manley, 25, of Toledo, Ohio was sentenced on Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fifth degree, and Escape, a felony of the third degree, to a total term of incarceration of three (3) years, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jarred L. Penrod, 19, of Inverness, Florida pleaded guilty to two (2) charges of Receiving Stolen Property, both felonies of the fifth degree and one (1) charge of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for September 24, 2009 at 9:30 a.m.
