These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Mark A. Seslar, 38, Edgerton, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drug of Abuse, a felony of the fourth degree, to a mandatory term of sixty (60) consecutive days plus an additional term of eighteen (18) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction and fined \$800.00.

Ronald J. Toomey, 27, Camden, Michigan pleaded guilty to the charge of Illegal Manufacturing of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree. He was sentenced to mandatory term of five (5) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Jerime N. Miler, 32, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Domestic Violence, a felony of the third degree, to four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Dawn R. Oiler, 32, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to Illegal Manufacture of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the second degree. Sentencing is scheduled for October 16, 2008 at 1:00 p.m.

Harlin R. Crowley, 19, Southport, Florida pleaded guilty to the charge of Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for October 15, 2008 at 2:00 p.m.

Ian C. Manley, 33, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for October 1, 2008 at 8:30 a.m.

Alex J. Metz, 19, Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to two counts of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, both felonies of the fourth degree. Sentencing scheduled for October 14, 2008 at 1:45 p.m.

Terra L. Shaner, 20, Hillsdale, Michigan pleaded guilty to the charges of Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fifth degree and Forgery, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for October 14, 2008 at 2:30 p.m.

Robert F. Urton, Jr., 46, Ney, Ohio pleaded guilty to two charges of Non-Support of Dependents, both felonies of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for October 14, 2008 at 2:15 p.m.
