### **December 17, 2009 NEWS RELEASE**

These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

James C. Kidd, 47, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charges of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, a felony of the third degree, and Aggravated Possession of Drugs, a felony of the first degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of twelve (12) years, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Edward M. Burger Jr., 38, Edgerton, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Aggravated Assault, a felony of the fourth degree, and Tampering with Evidence, a felony of the third degree, to a total term of incarceration of three (3) years, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Robert D. Blay, 25, of Jonesville, Michigan pleaded guilty to four (4) charges of Forgery, all felonies of the fifth degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of eleven (11) months, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Audie W. Ogden, 53, Williams County, Ohio pleaded guilty on the charge of Failure to Appear, a felony of the fourth degree. He was then sentenced on the Failure to Appear and a prior charge of Non-Support of Dependents, a felony of the fifth degree, to a total term of incarceration of seventeen (17) months, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Megan J. Sutton, 30, of Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the second degree to a term of two (2) years, to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Louise J. Berger, 48, of Napoleon, Ohio was sentenced on the charge of Identity Fraud, a felony of the fifth degree to three (3) years of community control.

Eric D. Zehr, 31, of Bryan, Ohio pleaded guilty to the charge of Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree. Sentencing is scheduled for January 20, 2010 at 1:00 p.m.
