These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

William R. Mohr, 32, of Bryan, Ohio, pleaded guilty to the charges of Illegal Assembly Or Possession Of Chemicals For The Manufacture Of Drugs (Methamphetamine), a felony of the third degree; and Theft, a felony of the fifth degree. He was then sentenced to a total term of incarceration of four (4) years to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Steven M. Kauffman, 28, of Stryker, Ohio, was sentenced on the charge of Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the fourth degree to six (6) months to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Toni L. Grove, 32, of Bryan, Ohio, was sentenced on the charge of Theft from a Disabled Adult, a felony of the third degree to three (3) years community control.

Russell L. Gyori, 26, of Montpelier, Ohio, pleaded guilty to the charge of Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of Police Officer, a felony of the third degree. Sentencing is scheduled for April 6, 2010, at 8:30 a.m.

Christopher J. Roland, 21, of Bryan, Ohio, was sentenced on the charge of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, a felony of the fourth degree to four (4) years' community control.

William R. Decker II, 31, of Bryan, Ohio, was sentenced on two (2) charges of Trafficking in Marihuana, both felonies of the fourth degree to three (3) years community control.

David M. Penrod, 47, of Montpelier, Ohio, was sentenced on a charge of Trafficking in Marihuana, a felony of the fifth degree to three (3) years community control.

Brent R. Hanenkrott, 18, of Defiance, Ohio, pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the charge of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree, to two (2) years community control.
