These persons appeared recently in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

Cheri M. Ingersoll, age 41, of Montpelier, Ohio, was sentenced on the charge of Illegal Assembly Or Possession Of Chemicals For The Manufacture Of Drugs, a felony of the third degree, to a term of 2 years of incarceration to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Danny G. Laroe Jr., age 29, of Homer, Michigan, pleaded guilty to the charge of Illegal Assembly Or Possession Of Chemicals For The Manufacture Of Drugs, a felony of the third degree. He was sentenced to a term of 2 years of incarceration to be served at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.

Brian E. Ebersole age 37, of Bryan, Ohio, pleaded guilty to the charges of Illegal Processing Of Drug Documents, a felony of the fifth degree and Deception To Obtain A Dangerous Drug, a felony of the third degree.
