These persons appeared today in the Williams County Common Pleas Court:

David M. Buehrer, 19, Bryan, Ohio was sentenced on the charges of Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree to a term of eight (8) months, Theft, a felony of the fifth degree to a term of eight (8) months, Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree to a term of eight (8) months, and Vandalism, a felony of the fifth degree to a term of eight (8) months to be served consecutively at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction for a total of 32 months.

Dennis A. Poling, 27, Bryan, Ohio, pleaded guilty to six counts of Vandalism, all felonies of the fifth degree, four counts of Breaking and Entering, all felonies of the fifth degree, one count of Burglary, a felony of the second degree, one count of Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree, one count of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree, and one count of Theft, a first degree misdemeanor. Sentencing is scheduled for June 11, 2006 at 2:15 p.m.

Jessica M. Walker, 28, Jackson, Michigan, pleaded guilty to Trafficking in Cocaine, a fourth degree felony. Sentencing is scheduled for June 11, 2007 at 2:45 p.m.

Julian Z. Zamora, 33, Paulding, Ohio pleaded guilty to a charge of Attempted Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of Police Officer, a felony of the fourth degree. He was sentenced to eighteen (18) months at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.
